

# LINGUISTICS

For graduation with an Associate in Arts (A.A.) Degree with a major in Linguistics :

1. Minimum Unit Requirements: Any course that appears on a curriculum guide and the General Education Pattern (Plan A) may fulfill both major and general education requirements (Approved by College Curriculum Committee Spring 2012). For this degree, complete a minimum of 60 units in courses numbered 1-599. Please note that additional elective units may be required to meet this minimum based upon courses selected to fulfill General Education for the Associate Degree.

Linguistics Major	18-22 units
General Education/A.A. §	25 units

2. Scholarship: Maintain an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher applied to the degree, no matter where completed. For this field of concentration, complete each course above with a **grade of "C" or better** on a standard basis.
3. Residence for the Degree: Complete at least 30 units of the required 60 in residence at LBCC, or complete in residence at LBCC at least 20 units within the last 30 units of work applied to the degree.
4. Residence for the Field of Concentration : Complete fifty percent (50%) or more of the unit requirements for this field of concentration in residence; this means at least 9 - 11 units of the required 18 - 22 must be completed at Long Beach City College . Credit earned by exam, where applicable, may be included.
