AP 5200 STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

The Student Health Center at each college is funded by the Student Health Fee (Education Code Section 76355) and shall be available upon request to students who are registered in the current term at the time of service and have paid the term health fee.

Title 5 Section 54702 establishes the types of health services the District may offer and specifies types of expenses for which the health services fee may be used.

The Student Health Center services are not comprehensive and are not structured to address all the health care needs of District students. It is not the intention of the healthcare professionals in the Student Health Center to be identified as primary healthcare providers. Students with ongoing chronic health concerns shall be referred tocommunity

health appraisal, screening, first aid, health and mental health counseling, nursing and/orother services;

- C. Health promotion activities;
- D. Programs and services designed to prevent illness and injury;
- E. Advising college administration in the implementation of all state and federal laws pertaining to college issues.

Student Accident Insurance

- a) A student accident insurance program
- b) Processing of student insurance claims and maintenance of claim records

Consultants

Consultants are hired to perform activities as needed. This may include consultants to assist with wellness programs and physician services.
